

Call for Papers

UMOP 39: Papers in Pragmatics

Deadline: Saturday, July 12th, 2008

We invite members of the UMass Linguistics community to submit their work on pragmatic theory to be published in a new working papers volume. We hope that the volume will include a wide range of topics (e.g., topic and focus structure, scalar implicature, prosodic realization, the interaction of semantics and pragmatics, etc.), and encourage submissions that evaluate recent developments in pragmatic theory, such as those that employ decision or game theoretic tools. We also encourage submissions on experimental work covering major themes guiding research in pragmatics, past and present.

In addition to a paper section, the volume will include a special section for squibs focusing on novel data and shorter fragments of pragmatic analysis. Papers should not exceed 25 pages and squibs should be approximately 2 – 4 pages long, with references.
